



Key Outcomes – 20 April 2010

At its 20 April 2010 meeting, the IBSA Board met at the IBSA office in East Melbourne. The Board:

- Noted the CEO's report highlighting the new Training Package endorsements and updates, the successful Sector Advisory Committee meetings held during March and April, the Skills Australia conference planning activities, IBSA's sponsorship of the Creative Innovation 2010 conference, and the Industry Skills Council forum on 1 June in Canberra
- Noted the current Training Package and applied research projects and received the priorities for the continuous improvement plan for future Training Package projects
- Noted the report on the Sector Advisory Committee activity
- Received the report on the Environment Scan 2010 highlighting the planned media activities and the proposals for Escan 2011 including expanded activities with associations and a stronger sector-specific focus
- Noted the paper on Workforce Development and the progress of IBSA's Enterprise Based Productivity Places Program projects
- Received a presentation on IBSA's products and services, with particular focus on the increasing number of support resources units now available for Business Services, Finance and Training & Assessment

- Noted the report on IBSA's innovation activities particularly the management and leadership research projects, the IBSA online enterprise innovation survey tool project and IBSA's partnership activities with innovative organisations
