

Key Outcomes – 9 February 2010

At its 9 February 2010 meeting, the IBSA Board met at the RACV Healesville Country Club in conjunction with the annual Strategic Planning Day with Sector Advisory Committee Chairs. The Board:

- Noted the CEO's report highlighting the activities around the broadening of qualifications in the new Training and Education Training Package, the progress in implementing the Government's green skills and flexibility rules in Training Packages, the work commissioned by the ISC Chairs around the Green Skills agenda and the key stakeholder engagement activities undertaken
- Received a presentation and noted the current Training Package projects, particularly qualifications shortly to be submitted to the National Quality Council for endorsement, and the priorities for the continuous improvement plan for future Training Package projects
- Received the draft Environment Scan 2010 report for discussion prior to submission to DEEWR by the end of February 2010, noting the overview section and the specific sectoral reports, highlighting the drivers for enterprises, the range of government imperatives and the future training requirements
- Noted the paper on Workforce Development and progress on the Enterprise Based Productivity Places Program
- Received a presentation on the progress of IBSA's products and services, with particular focus on the Business Services and Training & Assessment support resources
- Received the Finance and Operations Manager's summary report and the report of the Finance Audit and Risk Committee chair
- Noted the letter from the ISCs to Senator the Hon Mark Arbib, Minister for Employment Participation
- Noted the invitation to the Chair John Vines from Senator the Hon Mark Arbib, Minister for Employment Participation to participate in the Indigenous Employment Forum – Everybody's Business
