



Key Outcomes – 2 June 2009

At its 2 June 2009 meeting, the IBSA Board:

- Welcomed Craig Robertson, Group Manager Tertiary Skills and Productivity, Department of Education, Employment and Workplace Relations, who joined the meeting to present to the Board noting the particular challenges facing VET, including data collection, the ageing VET workforce, the high expectation of VET to provide solutions to the government's human capital agenda., and the strong role for ISCs into the future.
- Received an update from Board director Paul Byrne on the Training Packages for the 21st Century;
- Endorsed the 2009-2010 Budget;
- Noted the CEO's report highlighting the planning for IBSA's Innovation Summit to be held on 22 June 2009 with the support of Enterprise Connect, DEEWR and industry;
