Description:

Qualifications for Occupational Health and Safety (OHS) were developed between 2002 and 2004 at AQF Certificate IV, Diploma and Advanced Diploma levels. These qualifications were designed to meet the roles and responsibilities of full time OHS practitioners, safety specialists and managers. At the conclusion of that project, a need was identified to develop a lower level qualification for employees who do not have full time OHS responsibilities.

The Certificate III in Occupational Health and Safety was developed for those people who have a part time responsibility for OHS in the workplace, such as Health and Safety Representatives (HSRs), or to provide an entry point into OHS studies for anyone interested in developing their skills in the field of OHS. These Learner Guides are spiral bound, have underpinning text and include activities that can be used for either classroom or distance based learning.
